7.30(2)(a) "Except as authorized under subs. (1) (b) and (4) (c), all inspectors shall be affiliated with one of the 2 recognized political parties which received the largest number of votes for president, or governor in nonpresidential general election years, in the ward or combination of wards served by the polling place at the last election".

6.875(4)(a) "For the purpose of absentee voting in qualified retirement homes and residential care facilities, the municipal clerk or board of election commissioners of each municipality in which one or more qualified retirement homes or residential care facilities are located shall appoint at least 2 special voting deputies for the municipality." "The 2 deputies designated to visit each qualified retirement home and residential care facility shall be affiliated with different political parties whenever deputies representing different parties are available".

7.30(6)(c) "If any election official appointed under this section lacks the qualifications set forth in this section, fails to attend training sessions required under s. 7.15 (1) (e) unless excused therefrom, is guilty of neglecting his or her official duties or commits official misconduct, the municipal clerk or board of election commissioners shall summarily remove the official from office and the vacancy shall be filled under sub. (2) (b)".



## Step 5

In my official capacity as the Director of Election Integrity for the Republican Party of Waukesha County, I contacted Linda Gourdoux on 1/10/25 to inquire if the City of Waukesha was to have a February primary election and if so, when will the SVD availability/sign up email request will be sent out to all of the SVD's.

After several more emails, I was informed on 1/16/25 that a primary election will take place and I inquired on 1/17/25 as to when the availability email would be sent to all the SVD's. I received no response.

On 1/20/25 I sent an email to Linda reminding her of the names, email addresses and phone numbers of the 14 Republican nominated and appointed SVD's. I told her that 3 people who, for various reasons, could no longer serve as SVD's and wanted their names taken off of the list. I asked her to contact the remaining 11 people to work the 2025 elections. She forwarded my email to Mollie Schenk who facilitates SVD visits.

On 1/21/25 I called one of my SVD's and she informed me that she did receive the availability email from Mollie on 1/16/25 requesting everyone to get back to her with the dates and times they were able to work. I sent an email to Linda and Mollie asking why I didn't receive the availability email. No response from either.

On 1/22/25 I called the office and was told that Linda was not in and was told that I could leave a voice mail for Mollie. I asked her to call me as soon as possible in regard to the schedule for care facility visits. After several hours she did not call me back so I got in my car and went to City Hall to personally speak with her. I asked her why I did not receive the availability email and she responded that I wasn't going to be scheduled as a SVD and I should speak with Linda about it. I asked her if she had completed the schedule and if so, to send it to me. She responded that the schedule would be completed shortly and she would be sending it out. I did not receive the schedule so I called one of my SVD's to see if she received the schedule and she responded that Mollie sent it out at 4:17pm. While at City Hall I personally met with the mayor to go over with him the election law violations that his Clerk was committing.

On 1/24/25 I had a phone call with Linda to address my concern that both myself and Elaine Lukas (another nominated and appointed Republican SVD) were not contacted by Mollie for our available dates and time to work. Linda informed me that I would not be scheduled as an SVD because of some complaints from the November 2024 election. Linda never contacted me after the November election to discuss these complaints with me and at no time in all of the correspondence that Linda and I had between 1/10/25 through 1/22/25 did she ever tell me that I would not be scheduled to work as an SVD the Feb 2025 election. Please see the email

intitled "Meeting discussion of 1/24/25" which detail the complaints from the November 2024 election and my response to them.

Complaints 1 and 3 cannot even be contributed to me. Even if it were true, Complaints 2 & 4 do not meet the conditions of dismissal in 7.30(6)(c) or as stated in the Election Administration Manual August 2024 (page 137). In addition, this process of dismissal wasn't followed.

#### Removing Election Officials

As municipal clerk, you have the authority to dismiss an inspector summarily if he or she is found to lack the qualifications for the position, neglects his or her duties during an election, electioneers, or commits official misconduct. Wis. Stat. § 7.15(1)(f). However, in the interest of fairness, a hearing before the governing body is recommended before dismissal. Where it is found that an inspector has intentionally failed to properly endorse a ballot or intentionally given a voter a ballot not properly endorsed, that inspector should be suspended immediately by the chief inspector pending the filing of formal charges by the District Attorney. The chief inspector needs to inform the municipal clerk of such an action. The clerk fills the temporary vacancy for that election and schedules a hearing before the governing body to hear the case before taking final action.

In my meeting with Linda on 1/24/25 I also notified her that she was in violation of 7.30(2)(a). I would also refer Linda to the Election Administration Manual August 2024 (page 125), "Appointments must be made from the lists submitted by the parties for as long as election inspector positions are available. If party lists have been timely received, positions must be filled from the lists until the names on those lists have been depleted". She had no response to this.

I also informed her that she was currently in violation of 6.875(4)(a) as evidenced in the schedule for the February 2025 primary election. Please refer to email "SVD Schedule February 2025" and "City of Waukesha SVD schedule for February".

Notice that if there are six SVD's needed, there should be 3 Republicans scheduled even if the Democratic party didn't have 3 to serve. Even though I am/was available to serve as a SVD on 1/27, 1/29, 1/30 and 1/31, Linda continues to violate election law and has not revised the schedule to include my participation. I would also refer Linda to the Election Administration Manual August 2024 (page 125), "The two deputies designated to conduct absentee voting at each facility should be affiliated with different political parties whenever possible".

On 1/26/25 I sent an email to Linda asking her to confirm if an availability email was sent to Elaine Lukas and if so, the email address that it was sent to and the date it was sent. And if not, the reason/s why it wasn't sent.

On 1/29/25 I went to City Hall to ask Linda if she read my 1/24/25 email and to ask her to confirm if I accurately recapped our discussion and a follow up as to why Elaine Lukas did not receive an availability email. Linda was not in the office so I called and spoke with the mayor and asked for his assistance for her to respond to me. I also sent a follow up email for Linda to respond to.

In conclusion:

1. I never received prior notice of my removal as a SVD nor did any of the complaints against me rise to the level of my dismissal from office as defined in 7.30(6)(c). I also was never given a fair hearing before the body that appointed me to this office.
2. I was appointed to the 2024-2025 election cycle to serve as a Republican nominated SVD by the governing body of the City of Waukesha and in accordance with 7.30(2)(a). I should have been contacted to serve in the February 2025 primary election. Please refer to the Common Council print out from 12/5/23.
3. I was willing and able to serve but was denied the opportunity resulting in a lack of Republican SVD representation and the use of unaffiliated workers for the February 2025 primary election is in defiance of 6.875(4)(a) when Republicans were available.

## Meeting discussion of 1/24/25

Linda-

I requested a meeting with you to discuss my concerns about how absentee voting is administered at care facilities and particularly the time sensitive matter that I was not allowed to be scheduled for the February 2025 election that will begin on January 27, 2025.

Emails for availability were sent out to the SVD's, but Republican nominated and appointed Elaine Lucas and I did not receive this email.

In our phone conversation on 1/24/25 you told me that I would not be scheduled to work as a SVD in the City of Waukesha based on these four reasons and if I have mischaracterized your concerns, please let me know immediately upon receipt of this correspondence (I was scheduled to work as a SVD for the Nov 2024 election on Oct 16 and Oct 17. You did not specify but I am assuming that these complaints are in reference to Oak Hill Terrace on Oct 17. Please correct me if that assumption is incorrect):

1. I held up the line for voting.
2. I told some man that he couldn't assist his wife to vote.
3. The care facility had to call the clerk's office about the line not moving quickly enough so you had to send staff out to help conduct the voting and get the line moving.
4. I was spending time on my cell phone at the time the city was paying me.

You stated that I would not be scheduled to work as a SVD for these four reasons.

Let me first respond to points 1 and 3. You could not provide me with any examples of how I held up the voting or why you having to send out additional staff is a problem that I caused. You scheduled six people to work. Two people sat at a table and handed out certificate envelopes and ballots. I had nothing to do with this decision. That leaves two teams of 2 SVD's to work together as a team to personally offer each absentee elector an opportunity to cast his or her ballot (page 15 of the WEC manual dated January 2024 Absentee Voting in Residential Care Facilities and Retirement Homes and 6.875 (6) (c)).

I asked for the remaining 4 of us to work in teams of 2. One team consisted of me (R) and one Democrat (D), and the other team consisted of one Democrat and one Unaffiliated (U), in accordance with 6.875 (4) (a) (The 2 deputies designated to visit each qualified retirement home and residential care facility shall be affiliated with different political parties whenever deputies representing different parties are available).

It was obvious from the line of people wanting to vote that there were not enough people scheduled to conduct the vote. If you were thinking that 1 person would sit at the table and 5 SVD's would be left to conduct the vote with 5 voters at once, then you put me in the position of conducting the vote in noncompliance with election law. I asked you how you determined how many SVD's to send out to each location. I notice on your published schedule that you either scheduled 2 or 6 people per location. What is the number of people that you schedule for each location based on? You would not answer this question. I suggest that you look at the number of registered voters that requested an absentee ballot to determine the number of people that should be scheduled at each location to prevent long voting lines.

In this upcoming absentee voting at care facilities for the February primary, you have seven facilities with dates and time ranging from Monday January 27th through Friday January 31st. Two of these visits only require two people and in one case there is one (U) and one (R) and the other is one (R) and one (D). I have no objection to either of these but in the other five visits, in which 6 SVD's are scheduled, the Republican nominated and appointed SVD's are underrepresented by either 1 or 2.

I also mentioned to you that in the past, you have not had the proper mix of 1 Democrat and 1 Republican for the second visits that usually only require 2 people and that I had not been asked in the past to conduct the second visit.



These two points, SVD's working in teams of two and the teams consisting of one (R) and one (D) are the two most concerning process gaps that I wanted to meet with you about. I mentioned a couple of other minor concerns in our meeting today, but these are the main two that need to be addressed to bring your process in alignment with state election law.

In regard to point number 2, I would have never told some man that he couldn't assist his wife with voting by reading and marking her ballot at her direction. Who was this man and the name of the voter? Was this incidence reported on the EL-104svd?

In regard to point number 4, I can't say for certain whether I was looking at my cell phone or not but if I was, it probably would have been related with the election. I have used my cell phone at times to look up state statues to be sure that I knew what the law requires in certain situations. Regardless, I only would be looking at my phone or the WEC manual (Absentee Voting in Residential Care Facilities and Retirement Homes) during times when I am waiting for a voter to complete their ballot and never at times when a new voter can be moved into the common area.

I have addressed your concerns, and I would refer you to 7.30 (6) (c): If any election official appointed under this section lacks the qualifications set forth in this section, fails to attend training sessions required under s. 7.15 (1) (e) unless excused therefrom, is guilty of neglecting his or her official duties or commits official misconduct, the municipal clerk or board of election commissioners shall summarily remove the official from office and the vacancy shall be filled under sub. (2) (b).

I am asking you to provide me with documented evidence that I meet one or more of these conditions for removal from office.
