1. Purpose. This memorandum describes the availability and contact information for Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) support ahead of, and during, the 2024 General Election.

2. Extended Hours Ahead of Election Day.

Normal office hours for WEC support are Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. In addition to the normal schedule, WEC staff will be available to support clerks during the following times:

Saturday, October 26 th	10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
Sunday, October 27 th	10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
Thursday, October 31 st	7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Friday, November 1 st	7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Saturday, November 2 nd	10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Sunday, November 3 rd	10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Monday, November 4 th	7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

3. Election Day/Night Schedule

WEC Staff will be available for approximately 37 continuous hours starting at 5:00 a.m. on Election Day, November 5, 2024, and ending the following evening at 6:00 p.m., November 6, 2024.
