
I, Commissioner Ann Jacobs, Chairperson of the Wisconsin Elections Commission, certify that the attached tabular statements, as compiled from the certified returns made to the Wisconsin Elections Commission by the county clerks of the several counties of the state, contain a correct abstract of the total number of votes cast “for” and “against” the following proposed constitutional amendment:

**QUESTION 1: “*Eligibility to vote.*”** Shall section 1 of article III of the constitution, which deals with suffrage, be amended to provide that only a United States citizen age 18 or older who resides in an election district may vote in an election for national, state, or local office or at a statewide or local referendum?”

at an election held in the several cities, villages, towns, wards and election districts in said counties on the Fifth day of November 2024.

I DETERMINE AND CERTIFY that the proposed constitutional amendment relating to “*Eligibility to vote*” was approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.



I, ANN S. JACOBS, Chairperson of the Wisconsin Elections Commission, certify that the proposed constitutional amendment, reading as follows, was submitted to the people for approval and ratification at an election held on November 5, 2024:

**QUESTION 1: “*Eligibility to vote.* Shall section 1 of article III of the constitution, which deals with suffrage, be amended to provide that only a United States citizen age 18 or older who resides in an election district may vote in an election for national, state, or local office or at a statewide or local referendum?”**

I, FURTHER CERTIFY, that on November 29, 2024, the Chairperson of the Wisconsin Elections Commission examined the original returns compiled from the certified statements of the county boards of canvassers and determined that the referendum question was approved by a majority of the electors voting on the question based on the vote totals recorded on the attached statement.
